


lan and Heather

Our lives at home



Ian: I work remotely in communications for a local company. I enjoy my job and being available for anything our family needs during the day.




Fun on the water




Meet Heather!








Family camping trips

We started taking Joshua camping when he was 18 months old, and he has loved it ever since. We usually take a few weekend and week-long trips every summer.






