
Yasmin says...


Daniel says...

Daniel enjoys sports (especially football and basketball), coffee, hiking, and reading about world events.








Movie: Star Wars (the originals)


TV Show: Ted Lasso

others' backs.




Music: Thomas Rhett

We moved into our house four years ago and have taken great care to make it our home and an extension of who we are. It's colorful, warm, and full of life.






This is our favorite room in our house. It's often cloudy in our state, but if there is any light in the sky, it comes in through the skylights in this room!


Daniel says...


